Proceedings of Town Trustees Meeting held in the Town of Springfield*

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met February 10th, 2021 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Clerk Robert Remack.

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of January 13, 2021 were reviewed. A motion was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Mike Morris to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bills were submitted to the Town Board for authorization to pay. A motion was made by Shannon Lynch and seconded by Arthur Watts that said bills be authorized for payment. All voted aye. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: \$100.00 was collected from the dumpster program on the first Saturday of the month.

NEW BUSINESS: Clerk Robert Remack reported the 21-22 budgets will be discussed at the March Board Meeting and voted on at the regular town board meeting in April.

Rick Schuster reported on reimbursement the township received from the State for COVID-19 related expenses. Personal equipment, \$481.20; spring food giveaway, \$6,692.66; employee expenses, \$3,074.50. Total reimbursement, \$10,248.36.

Clerk Robert Remack announced the re-scheduled 2020 Annual Town Meeting will be held at 6:30 following tonight's board meeting.

Attorney Don LoBue submitted to the Board the Intergovernmental Mutual Aid Agreement between Springfield Township and Village of Grandview to be voted on at the March Board Meeting.

Motion to adjourn was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Shannon Lynch. All voted aye. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:12 p.m.
