Proceedings of Town Trustees Meeting held in the Town of Springfield*

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met April 13th, 2021 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

Present: Supervisor Gary Budd, Trustees Shannon Lynch, Mike Morris, Arthur Watts, Clerk Robert Remack, Assessor Cinda Sausaman, Road Commissioner Ron Smith, Collector Janine Stroble. Excused: Trustee Don Willett.

**Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.**

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of March 10, 2021 were reviewed. A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Shannon Lynch to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bills were submitted to the Town Board for authorization to pay. A motion was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Shannon Lynch that said bills be authorized for payment. All voted aye. Motion carried.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** \$60.00 was collected from the dumpster program on the first Saturday of the month.

**NEW BUSINESS:** A motion was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Mike Morris to pass Town Budget Ordinance #2021-2022-01. An individual voice vote taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Shannon Lynch to pass Road District Budget Ordinance #2021-2022-02. An individual voice vote taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Supervisor Gary Budd said he wants to have another food giveaway in June. Said the Township received \$6,500.00 covid-19 reimbursement from the federal government. Fliers will be sent out to residents and he will contact Turaskys and County Market.

He said he has a couple quotes from a company from Edwardsville to hold an electronic recycling event, possibly in September. Option 1 is for \$2,550.00 which includes 18 cents per pound for CRT monitors, plasma and CRT TVs, 22 cents per pound for projection and console televisions, 15 cents per pound for LCD and LED monitors, 50 cents per pound for broken televisions and tubes. Option 2 would cost \$300.00 more and depending on size would cost residents and business's \$5.00 to \$35.00 for CTR, projection, plasma, flat screen and console televisions and depending on the size \$5.00 to \$20.00 for LCD, LED, CRT monitors. CJD will collect the fee. He also discussed getting a quote from BLH.

Also, after checking for legality, he said he hopes to start up a food pantry for township residents by July.

Collector Janine Stroble reported the township will not be collecting real estate taxes this year. Tax bills will not have the township mailing address. Residents can pay to the county by mail, in person or at the INB drive thru. Tax bills will be mailed the 2<sup>nd</sup> week in May. Due dates are June 11th and September 10th and the township will received their distribution electronically.
