**Proceedings of Town Trustees Meeting held in the Town of Springfield**

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met May 10, 2017 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

**Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.**

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting & Annual Town Meeting held April 11, 2017 were reviewed. A motion was made by Don Willett and seconded by Mike Morris to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bills were submitted to the Town Board for authorization to pay. A motion was made by Art Watts and seconded by Shannon Lynch that said bills be authorized for payment. All voted aye. Motion carried.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** \$360.00 was collected from Dumpster Program Operations this month.

Chairman Gary Budd said he discussed the idea of a township flag with Township Officials. They thought it was a good idea and suggested contacting the north end elementary schools. Students could design the flag as an art class project. Some ideas they suggested were to represent the fairgrounds, route 66 or the airport in the design. Since the school year is almost over, this will be considered for the next school year.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Becky Nevill, Consultant with Ambit energy did not show.

**GENERAL TOWN REPORT BY SUPERVISOR:** The mandatory audit will begin as of June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Chairman Gary Budd said he is in the process of talking with Mike Johnson with the City of Springfield regarding obtaining water to the township property. Annexation to the City may be required, although the Township may be exempt. Lindsey Electric & F&W do not want to annex. The City is to get back to him with the cost.

On behalf of the Board, Clerk Robert Remack presented retiring Road Commissioner George Ruzic with a plaque thanking him for his 12 years of service.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts. All voted aye. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
