Proceedings of Town Trustees Meeting held in the Town of Springfield

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met June 08, 2022 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

Present: Supervisor Gary Budd, Trustees Mike Morris, Arthur Watts, Shelly Turnbull, Clerk Robert Remack, Road District Commissioner Ron Smith, Assessor Cinda Sausaman. Excused: Trustee Shannon Lynch.

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of May 11, 2022 were reviewed. A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Supervisor Gary Budd asked to include in approval of payment the amount \$14,882.36 for a new bobcat mower purchased by Ron Smith to arrive in 3 to 6 months. Supervisor Gary Budd reported on the 32nd St. Ridgewood Ave. Water Project. He spoke with Senator Durbin's office. They were going to call into Washington and wanted to know how many residents in the township has water. He estimated 85%. They are to get back to him.

Attorney John Kerley said action on the burnt out mobile home on S. Wesley is on hold pending a legal opinion from States Attorney's Office.

Attorney John Kerley updated the Board regarding the car lot on S. Wesley. He said he understands Secretary of State raided his house. Secretary of State's Office was unable to give him information on an ongoing investigation.

Supervisor Gary Budd said he signed the papers for the paving of the Administration Building parking lot and Ron Furman may be able to complete job by end of month.
