Proceedings of Town Trustees Meeting held in the Town of Springfield

Due to electronic difficulty, this meeting was not recorded on zoom.

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met September 08th, 2021 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

Present: Supervisor Gary Budd, Trustees Shannon Lynch, Mike Morris, Arthur Watts, Shelly Turnbull, Clerk Robert Remack, Road Commissioner Ron Smith. Assessor Cinda Sausaman. Excused: Collector Janine Stroble.

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of August 11, 2021 were reviewed. A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Shelly Turnbull to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bills were submitted to the Town Board for authorization to pay. A motion was made by Shannon Lynch and seconded by Arthur Watts that said bills be authorized for payment. All voted aye. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: \$150.00 was collected from the dumpster program the first Saturday of the month.

Supervisor Gary Budd said the township is continuing to talk to Senator Durbin's office about federal funding for the 32nd St & Ridgewood Ave. Water Project. They are looking at federal programs along with the infrastructure bill which has not be passed yet. If successful, installation will be done in two phases.

NEW BUSINESS: A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts to pass the audit draft year ending March 2021. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts to pass the electronic recycling bid submitted by BLH Electronics. Under option 2 the township will pay 50% up to 100lbs. per customer up to a maximum of \$3,000.00 after which the customer would pay the full .25 per lb. for all video display devices and .10 per lb. for other mixed electronics. Transportation will be bill at \$200.00 per box truck with a maximum of \$400.00. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Supervisor Gary Budd reported the second tax installment will be made to township on September 11.

Motion to adjourn was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Shannon Lynch. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
