Proceedings of Town Trustees Meeting held in the Town of Springfield

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met October 14th, 2020 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

Present: Supervisor Gary Budd, Trustees Shannon Lynch, Don Willett, Mike Morris, Arthur Watts, Clerk Robert Remack, Assessor Cinda Sausaman, Road Commissioner Ron Smith. Excused: Collector, Janine Stroble.

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of September 09, 2020 were reviewed. A motion was made by Shannon Lynch and seconded by Mike Morris to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bills were submitted to the Town Board for authorization to pay. A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts that said bills be authorized for payment. All voted aye. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: \$150.00 to \$160.00 was collected from the dumpster program on the first Saturday of the month.

Supervisor Gary Budd said the Township is still waiting on response from the IL. Dept. of Public Health regarding the 32nd St Ridgewood Ave. water project. He said Cherril will contact them again.

He also reported the Township has received e-mail from the state saying they have received our application for Covid-19 reimbursement and is in the process of working on it.

NEW BUSINESS: A motion was made by Shannon Lynch and seconded by Mike Morris to approve resolution #2020-2021-03 setting the elected official's salaries for the next 4 years. (Supervisor: \$13,750.00, Road District Treasurer: \$1,000.00, Assessor: \$12,600.00, Clerk: \$8,600.00, Highway Commissioner: \$20,750.00, Trustee: \$2,100.00.) Individual voice vote taken. All voted aye.

Supervisor Gary Budd said the tax levies are due at next board meeting.

GENERAL TOWN REPORT BY SUPERVISOR: Supervisor Gary Budd said the City of Springfield and EPA is holding a hazardous waste collection at the State Fairgrounds on November 7th. For registration and more information go to the City website under hazardous collection.

He said as of January the board meetings will be broadcast live.

The newsletter is going out after Thanksgiving. Food giveaway will be held December 12th. Everyone in the township qualifies with no income requirement.
