Proceedings of Town Trustees Meeting held in the Town of Springfield

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met October 13th, 2021 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

Present: Supervisor Gary Budd, Trustees Shannon Lynch, Mike Morris, Arthur Watts, Shelly Turnbull, Clerk Robert Remack, Road Commissioner Ron Smith. Excused: Collector Janine Stroble, Assessor Cinda Sausaman.

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of September 08, 2021 were reviewed. A motion was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Shannon Lynch to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bills were submitted to the Town Board for authorization to pay. A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts that said bills be authorized for payment. All voted aye. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: \$150.00 was collected from the dumpster program the first Saturday of the month.

The township will be holding an electronic recycling event Saturday, October 16th. Recycling will be available to township residents' 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and shredding will be available 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. Supervisor Gary Budd said the township was able to secure a weight scale from Turaskys.

Supervisor Gary Budd said township is waiting for the infrastructure bill to pass for federal funding of the 32nd St & Ridgewood Ave. Water Project.

NEW BUSINESS: Supervisor Gary Budd stated tax levies are due at November board meeting. He said the tax levies will be set at 4% increase of last year's levies.

Supervisor Gary Budd said the democratic party has requested to use the township building to hold a town meeting with residents of the township on Saturday, November 13th. A motion was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Shelly Turnbull to allow both political parties to use the township administration building for town hall meetings at no charge. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Supervisor Gary Budd announced the retirement of Township Attorney Don LoBue and introduced the new Township Attorney John Kerley whose appointment will be voted on at the November Board Meeting.

Motion to adjourn was made by Shannon Lynch and seconded by Arthur Watts. All voted aye. Motion carried.
