The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met November 10th, 2021 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

**Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.**

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of October 13, 2021 were reviewed. A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bills were submitted to the Town Board for authorization to pay. A motion was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Shannon Lynch that said bills be authorized for payment. All voted aye. Motion carried.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** \$206.00 was collected from the dumpster program the first Saturday of the month.

Supervisor Gary Budd's update on recycling event held October 16<sup>th</sup>... The township has not received a bill from BLH yet. Affordable Shred billed \$250.00. Trustee Mike Morris asked how much cash was collected by the township. Supervisor responded \$225.00.

32<sup>nd</sup> Street & Ridgewood Ave. Project... Supervisor Gary Budd said the federal infrastructure bill passed and the Township is in the bill. He should know more after speaking with Bill Houlihan.

**NEW BUSINESS:** A motion was made by Shannon Lynch and seconded by Shelley Turnbull to pass Resolution#2021-2022-04, Town Levy in the amount of \$250,796.00. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Shelley Turnbull to pass Resolution #2021-2022-05, Road District Levy in the amount of \$261,340.00. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts to appoint John Kerley as Township Attorney to replace retiring Attorney Don LoBue. An individual voice vote was taken. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Supervisor Gary Budd reported the township Christmas basket giveaway will be held on December 11<sup>th</sup> starting at 8:00 a.m. He anticipates the cost to increase by 5 to 6 hundred dollars this year.
