Proceedings of Town Trustees Meeting held in the Town of Springfield

The Board of Trustees of Springfield Township met December 14, 2022 at the Township Administration Building at 3298 Terminal Ave, Springfield, IL.

Present: Supervisor Gary Budd, Trustees Arthur Watts, Shelly Turnbull, Shannon Lynch, Mike Morris, Clerk Robert Remack, Road District Commissioner Ron Smith. Excused: Assessor Cinda Sausaman.

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Gary Budd.

The Treasurer's report and minutes of the Board Meeting of November 09, 2022 were reviewed. A motion was made by Arthur Watts and seconded by Mike Morris to accept the treasurer's report and approve the minutes. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Bills were submitted to the Town Board for authorization to pay. A motion was made by Shannon Lynch, seconded by Arthur Watts that said bills be authorized for payment. Added to these bills is \$5,600.00 to \$5,700.00 for a new salt spreader paid for out of carryover funds from last year. An inter-governmental agreement between the Town and Road District will be prepared. All voted aye. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: \$50.00 was collected from the dumpster program held the first Saturday of the month.

Supervisor Gary Budd said he and Township Attorney John Kerley is working with the Board of Election's Office on the proposed referendum paperwork to be submitted by January 17th.

NEW BUSINESS: A motion was made by Shelly Turnbull and seconded by Mike Morris to approve the 2023 office closings schedule. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Supervisor Gary Budd reported the budgets are due to clerk's office by February 1st.

He said the food giveaway was a success.

Motion to adjourn was made by Mike Morris and seconded by Arthur Watts. All voted aye. Motion passed.
